Premiering works

Various international artists will present global premieres of works and series at Haute Photographie. In addition to this, Haute Photographie will showcase premiering works by **Jitske Schols** from the series 'Songs for Soprano', represented by Galerie [Caroline O'Brien](#), from **Toshiya Watababe's** series 'Somewhere not Here', represented by [Ibasho](#), from **Nick Brandt's** series 'New Empty World', represented by [Atlas Gallery](#), from **Bruno V. Roels'** series 'Fake Billboards', represented by [Gallery Fifty One](#), and **Michael Søndergaard's** series 'RITE', represented by [The Little Black Gallery](#) will be premiering at Haute Photographie.

A wide range of genres

The group exhibition at Haute Photographie will include over 300 works by more than 50 photographers, which together represent a wide range of genres within the medium. Alongside the group exhibition, two focus exhibitions will offer an in-depth look at both the future and the past of photography. The **Haute Talent exhibition** will showcase the most intriguing [photography talents](#) based in the Netherlands: Lucas Hardonk, Merel Schoneveld, BILENBILEN, Joost Termeer, Lisette Appeldorn, and Nora Papp. **The Vintage Section** will present vintage artworks from the collections of the participating galleries, bringing together key names from the history of photography, including Christer Strömholm, Sanne Sannes and Werner Bischof.

In collaboration with the neighbouring Nederlands Fotomuseum, Haute Photographie offers a program ranging from **daily guided tours** of both the museum's exhibitions and the fair, a **special scavenger hunt** for children age 6 - 12 and a diverse range of **presentations and panel discussions**.

Program highlights include [portfolio reviews](#) for budding photographers with reviewers **Mick Peet** (Financial Times), **Lisa Klaverstijn** (Volkskrant), **Birgit Donker** (director

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Nederlands Fotomuseum), and **Anaïs López** (Visual Artist). **Martijn van den Broek** (head of collections Nederlands Fotomuseum) and **Willemijn van der Zwaan** (co-curator Haute Photographie) will give special tours for beginning collectors on preservation and collecting of photography. Artist talks will be held by **Rein Jelle Terpstra** about his exhibition in the Nederlands Fotomuseum. Additionally, Haute Photographie is proud to host a **panel discussion on women in photography** with renowned artists **Carla van de Puttelaar**, **Laura Hospes** and more, moderated by Curator of Photographs at the Victoria & Albert Museum, **Catherine Troiano**. On Saturday and Sunday, visitors can have their portrait taken unlike any other in the **Portret Studio of Maarten Bel**.

Haute Photographie is an international photography fair with a refreshing take on the fair format. Initiated by Roy Kahmann, director of Kahmann Gallery, publisher of GUP Magazine, and a long-term advocate of photography in the Netherlands, Haute was officially launched as part of Art Rotterdam Week in February 2017. The fair takes a carefully curated exhibition as its starting point, which provides a fascinating look at photography as a fine art medium. Accompanied by a focus exhibition on young Dutch photography talent, a talks program in association with Nederlands Fotomuseum, a book market, and more, Haute will return to be a must-visit during the Rotterdam Art Week 2019, one of the key events in contemporary art in the Netherlands.
